

Conduct a survey about openness to learning and technology.

Directions:

As a manager for a major electronics firm, you have been assigned to find out how open the employees are to learning new things, particularly involving technology. To complete your assignment, you decide to design a survey and give it to a sampling of employees.

1. Use the *Being Open to Learning and Technology* rubric.
2. Use items on the rubric to assist you in designing a 10-item survey to find out how open people are to learning and technology.
3. Locate five people to complete the survey.
4. Have them imagine they work for your electronics firm and fill out the survey.
5. Tabulate the results.
6. Summarize your findings.
7. Circle items on the *Being Open to Learning and Technology* rubric that you include on your survey.

Submit: Survey, results, summary, rubric. **Estimated Hours:** 1.0

Suggestions:

1. Think about several learning and technology situations that are 1) difficult and 2) meaningful to you.
2. Use a 5-1 scale. Then define the five numbers specifically. For example, 5 = strongly agree, 4 = agree, and so on. Or, 5 = exactly like me, 4 = like me, and so on.
3. Include a graph with your results.
