

## Measuring Items Greater Than One Unit

To the right, 2 = Mastery, 1 = Acceptable (may improve), 0 = Not acceptable (must improve).  
 On the blanks to the left, mark "+" for strengths and "-" for areas that need improvement.

**Measures a variety of items that are more than one unit.**

2 1 0

- Length: more than one foot, in feet and inches.
- Volume: more than one quart, in quarts and cups.
- Weight: more than one pound, in pounds and ounces.

**Prepares to measure items.**

2 1 0

- Estimates measure.
- Selects appropriate tool.
- Selects the appropriate unit.
- Determines how accurate to measure (1/2 unit error).

**Measures whole units accurately.**

2 1 0

- Locates the "0" point on measuring tool.
- Measures from "0" point to end of measuring tool.
- Counts each whole as one whole unit.
- Continues measuring whole units until end point reached.

**Identifies remaining part that is less than one unit.**

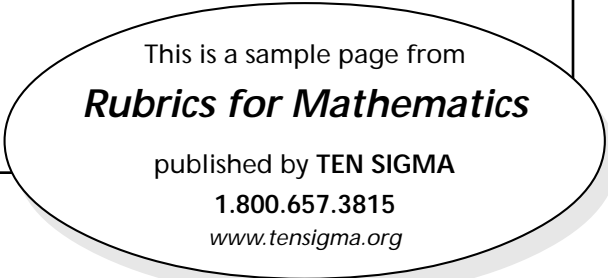
2 1 0

- Measures remaining part.
- Identifies ending measure to appropriate accuracy.

**Writes entire measure to correct unit (whole and part).**

2 1 0

- Counts number of whole measures.
- Adds remaining part of the measure.
- Writes entire measure correctly.
- Labels measurement with correct unit.
